#### TREASURER REPORT

(Wayne Grunewald – Class of 1974)

Our cash position has improved by \$10,400 during the past 23 months, since my last Treasurer Report to you, as shown in the table below.

#### \$16,300 Cash Balance as of November 30, 2012


- 15,900 Alumni Dues and Additional Contributions
- 4,200 Mortgage Note Receipts
- (3,200) Actives Liability Insurance
- (2,400) Fraternity Clubhouse Rent
- (2,500) Alumni Communications
- (1,600) Alumni Social Events

#### \$26,700 Cash Balance as of October 31, 2014

Alumni contributed \$15,900 during the past 23 months, of which \$8,800 (55%) has come through donations to Carroll University, with DRU as the designated recipient. This has become an excellent way for DRU Alumni to donate at the same time to both Carroll and DRU. We have also received \$4,200 of monthly mortgage payments from the buyer of our fraternity house. The mortgage note pays a small amount of monthly principal plus 6% interest, with a \$28,800 balloon payable to us in the next several months.

60% of our recent expenses have been in support of the DRU Active Body, as we have committed to paying for 30% of the Carroll-required liability insurance policy premium and for the Clubhouse rental. 40% of our expenses have been in support of Alumni communications and social events.

Your continued financial support is very much appreciated to help pay for our Active Body financial commitments and for DRU Alumni Association ongoing costs. There is a separate form in this SCOOP to make your 2014/2015 dues payment, if you have not already done so.


#### **Delmont Louis**
